## ■ Athlete Eligibility

Open to individuals with an intellectual disability and designed to increase fitness levels, develop individual and/or team skills, promote sportsmanship and fair play. No person shall, on the grounds of gender, race, religion, ability level or financial constraint, be excluded from participation. The following programs are designed for young athletes: Active Start (2-6 years), FUNdamentals (7-12 years), Sport Start Soccer (13-18 years), and Sport Start Track & Field (13-18 years). Please note that for safety reasons, some programs require experience and/or an athlete assessment.

## ■ Registration

The registration process includes 2 forms:

- 1) Yearly medical form
- 2) SOBC Provincial registration form for new athletes
